1	There are a total of (10) error messages that can appear on the LCD screen of any Grand Series machine. They are as follows:	
	1) Over-Current Top Server Motor Error	
	2) Feedback Top Server Motor Error	
	3) Over-Current Bottom Server Motor

	4) Feedback Bottom Server Motor Error	
	5) Over-Current Sweep Motor Error	
	6) Feedback Sweep Motor Error	
	7) Over-Current Elevation Motor Error

	10) Battery Depleted Error	
	10) Battery Depicted Error	
2	An Over-Current Error means that there is some	
	type of obstruction or a "drag" on the motor that is	
	depicted by the error message. A Feedback Error	
	refers to an issue regarding the information being	
	relayed from the motor back to the control panel.	
3	Special Note- The Grand Series machines are	
	designed to provide an error message if any issue	
	arises. The most common reason is generally a	
	Ball Jam. Please refer to trouble shooting	
	instruction "I Have A Ball Jam", on the Lobster	
	Sports website.
